Princess Margareta Range

RED

Type of whine: Red, dry

Variety: Marselan

Harvest Year: 2018

Alcohol: 14% vol.

Tasting notes: The first Romanian wine made 100% from the Marselan variety, planted for the first time in the vineyards of Segarcea in 2005. For this wine, the production was limited to 5 tons of grapes per hectare, to ensure a special extract. Flavours of strawberry jam, raspberries, blueberries, tobacco, spices, cocoa, milk chocolate, rum and coconut. The taste is complex, gradually revealing itself, from the explosion of fruits to the secondary tones of spices, completed with a long and elegant aftertaste of liquor ice and milk chocolate. It has a great ageing power.

Recommended serving temperature: 16°C-18°C. It is necessary to open the bottle half an hour before serving and for the wine to be decanted. Any deposits certify the minimum number of interventions that are made on the wine.

Additional information about the Princess Margareta wine collection: From the early days of 1990, when Her Royal Highness Margareta of Romania returned among the Romanians fresh out of the sad communist era and to this day, the Crown Princess has become a symbol for all values forgotten or ignored in the previous half-century - honesty, respect compared to tradition, passion for excellence, modesty, volunteerism, humanism and charity. Through his daily actions, in all these years, Her Royal Highness has been a pioneer in the formation of a responsible elite, which would lay the foundations of Romania's moral rebirth.

In September 2010, the "Domeniul Coroanei" Segarcea officially became the supplier of the Royal House of Romania again, thus regaining the place its establishment by His Majesty King Carol I, was intended for. At the request of Her Royal Highness, Princess Margareta, we created two special wines, in limited editions. We tried to include in them, both the gratitude for the history that linked our destiny to the Royal House of Romania and the promise that we will never deviate from the standards of excellence that have consecrated to this day, the name of the Segarcea vineyard. The history lesson that the Segarcea vineyard shows to the world every day is that a really well-done work does not fall upon the passage of time, nor upon the influence of people. Even in the darkest times of communist nationalization and collectivization, the name Segarcea remained a landmark of quality, as desired by its founder, His Majesty, King Carol I. In recognition, today's company remains dedicated to the values born at the same time with the Law for the Crown Domain, on June 10th (22nd) 1884: excellence, tradition, love and respect for the land.
